Over three evenings a series of talks will be given that unveil some of the highlights and hidden moments of New Zealand fashion history. Douglas Lloyd Jenkins and Lucy Hammonds, partnered by Claire Regnault are together currently working on a comprehensive book on New Zealand Fashion Since 1945 – to be published by Random House 2010. These lectures use research from the book and the collections of the Hawke's Bay Museum & Art Gallery to give a preview of the spectacular revelations from New Zealand fashion history to come.

HBMAG Director Douglas Lloyd Jenkins will talk about New Zealand fashion in the 1940s and 1950s – profiling pioneer boutique designers Trilby Yates, Bobby Angus and Flora McKensie. His second presentation will uncover the birth of a local 1960s style. HB MAG curator Lucy Hammonds will then reveal the rising hemlines and changing attitudes of 1970s Kiwi fashion.
