Duration: 1 ½ hours Suitable Years 4 - 13 Cost: \$4.10 per student

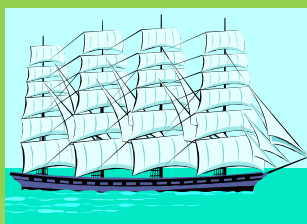
Available all year round but bring a raincoat if wet.

Meeting point: the Old Customhouse on Customs Quay.

Bring your class on a special tour of Ahuriri to discover what it used to be like before the 1931 Earthquake. Learn about the history of this special area and the activities that the area has seen: Maori occupation, whaling, trading, and the effect of the 1931 Earthquake on the geographical layout.

Meet at the historic Customhouse and see the mini Museum contained within. Finish with an art activity in the building. Bring snack food and cameras.
